The UNLV Lady Rebels will open the 1992-93 season when it hosts the 14th-annual 7UP Desert Classic in the UNLV South Gym Friday and Saturday.

The Lady Rebels are 17-1 lifetime in season-openers and 14-1 at home.

On Friday, the Alabama-Birmingham Lady Blazers face the University of San Diego Lady Toreros in the opener at 5:30 p.m. Later, the Lady Rebs host the Tennessee-Chattanooga Lady Mocs at 7:30 p.m.

On Saturday, both the consolation and championship games will be played at the South Gym. The action starts at 5:30 p.m.

The Tennessee-Chattanooga Lady Mocs were 18-12 last season and tied for first place in the Southern Conference at 8-2. The Lady Blazers of AlabamaBirmingham finished the 1991-92 season with a 24-8 overall record and topped the Great Midwest Conference with an 8-

UNLV, which was 16-10 overall last season and finished second in the Big West Conference with a 13-5 record, has nei-

ther played the Lady Mocs nor the Lady Blazers. The Lady Rebels hold a series record of 7-0 against San Diego and defeated the Lady Toreros 71-61 on Dec. 29, 1990.

Jim Bolla, the dean of Big West women's basketball coaches, is in his 11th season at UNLV. With an overall record of 238-70, he is 10th on the winningest active Division I coaches list.

In last year's tournament, Stanford captured the title from the Lady Rebels, who had won four straight before their defeat. The Cardinal eventually won the NCAA Women's Basketball Championship last season.


