

## No. 23 Rebels storm **Long Beach State**

UNLV took on another Big West opponent again and promptly flattened them at the Bolla Bowl. In front of 1,100 and a national, cable-television audience, the Lady Rebels defeated the Long Beach State, 94-67.

Forward Theresa Jackson, who led the team with 25 points and 10 rebounds, earned another double-double this season. Jackson also had a game-high six steals.

Trudie Hopgood shot 80 per cent (8-10) from the field and converted 7 out of 8 free throws for a 23-point effort.

Three-point extraordinare Gwynn Hobbs, whose offense was virtually nonexistent in the first half, nailed 3 threepointers in the second half to seal the victory.

"When Gwynn hits a three, it's a great weapon," said UNLV coach Jim Bolla about the sophomore guard's second-half comeback. Hobbs finished the evening with 14 points.

Guard Cherie Hogg added 13 points and 5 steals for the night.

The victory, the tenth in a row for UNLV. proved that the Lady Rebels are indeed worthy of a national ranking. This was

UNLV's first victory over Long Beach State since the 1990-91 season.

"It's a great opportunity for the kids," said Bolla about the game which was televised nationally on ESPN.

In the game's opening ten minutes of the first half, both teams traded baskets and tied eight times in that stretch. But the Lady Rebels came back with a 23-10 run capped by a lay-up from Tonia Carter and a plethora of Long Beach State turnovers.

"They (the 49'ers) have been averaging a lot of turnovers," said the UNLV coach about Long Beach State's ball handling. The 49'ers had 20 first-half turnovers and totaled 32 for the game.

Said Bolla about their No. 23 ranking: "I'm real happy for them that we got ranked this week. I kinda thought we may not get ranked until after the (Saturday's) Santa Barbara game."


Long Beach State guard Neisha Williams led the Gauchos with 20 points and dished out five assists. 49'er forward Marsheela Harriston added 16 points and 13 rebounds.

The up-tempo Lady Rebels improve their record at 13-1 and 7-0 in the Big West. Long Beach State fall to 4-11 overall, 3-5 in conference.
