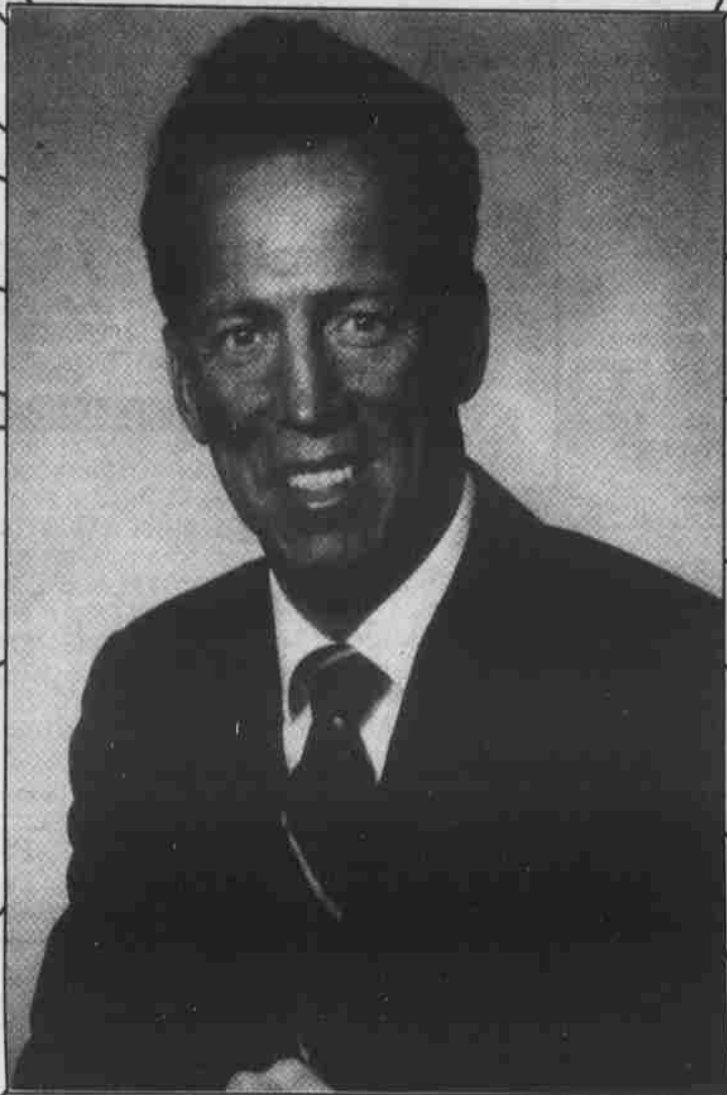

Teresa Jackson wins SI Player of the Week

UNLV women's basketball senior Teresa Jackson earned Player of the Week honors from *Sports Illustrated* magazine. Jackson, a 5-11 forward, averaged 24.5 points and 7.5 rebounds last week against Big West rivals Long Beach State and UC Santa Barbara.

Anita Maxwell, a New Mexico State freshman, edged out Jackson for Big West Conference Player of the Week. Maxwell, also a 5-11 forward, averaged 24.7 points and 14 rebounds in helping her team to a 2-1 record last week.

Baseball kicks off 1993 season

UNLV's baseball team was picked to finish sixth in the Big West Conference as selected by the head coaches of the conference. Picked 1-2 are CS Fullerton and Long Beach State, both College World Series participants last year.

UNLV plays three preseason games this weekend against Lewis-Clark State. Game one starts Friday at 3 p.m. at Roger Barnson Memorial Field. Regular season competition begins Feb. 12 when the Hustlin' Rebels host New Mexico for a three-game series.

Softball hosts junior college champions

UNLV softball, picked fourth in the conference by Big West head coaches, begins the 1993 season by hosting three exhibition games against Central Arizona College, the defending national junior college champions for the last five years. Game one begins 3 p.m. Friday at Rebel Diamond. UNLV, which finished the 1992 season ranked sixth in the nation, will attempt to earn its fourth straight playoff appearance.

The Lady Rebels begin their regular season on Feb. 13, hosting UC Santa Barbara in a Big West doubleheader.
