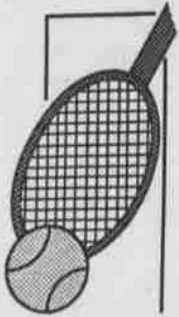

"The field includes strong teams," said head tennis coach Larry Easley.

Southern Methodist University, Boise State, Fresno State, San Diego State, Weber State, and Northern Arizona University will compete in this annual tournament.

The Rebels face Weber State in a 1 p.m. match-up tomorrow.

The women's team will face the Texas A & M Aggies at 1 p.m. Saturday at Spanish Trail Country Club.

Softball team travels to Arizona State for tourney

The 12th-ranked UNLV softball team (2-0 overall, 2-0 in the Big West) will face its toughest weekend of the season when it travels to the Arizona State Coca-Cola Classic on Feb. 19-21. The Lady Rebels will play five games in the round-robin tournament held in Tempe, Ariz., all against ranked teams.

UNLV opens the tournament Friday with top-ranked UCLA (3-1) followed in the evening by 19th-ranked Arizona State (2-0).

On Saturday the Lady Rebels will play conference rival and 15th-ranked Utah State.

UNLV closes out the tournament on Sunday with a match-up against No. 2 Arizona followed immediately by 7th-ranked Oklahoma State.

All-American Tricia Reimche went 3-for-8 against UC Santa Barbara Saturday. The Lady Rebels lead-off hitter increased her school-record career hit total to 208.

Jackson (20 points, six rebounds), UNLV's post players overpowered Southern Utah State, a lower division, independent school. Jackson and mid-season arrival Tonia Carter (14 points, 14 rebounds) had three blocks apiece against the smaller, less physical Thunderbirds.

In the absence of Hopgood, guard rotation became impossible. Gwynn Hobbs (15 points, five assists) and Cherie Hogg (18 points, six assists) combined for 77 minutes, but showed little fatigue.

The lack of guard depth did show up in the stats, though. The pair combined for 11 turnovers and shot progressively worse as time took its toll.


With no guards to turn to, Bolla opted to work post players from the bench. Starting center Vivian Johnson (five points, three rebounds, three assists) played

20 minutes, allowing reserve centers Iris Dinerman (two points, two rebounds) and Tracy Titus (six points, five rebounds) some long-awaited playing time.

"We need to go inside and get them (reserve centers) familiar with what to do when they get the ball," Bolla said.

Defense, however, was not as successful. The Lady Rebels, though well ahead from early on, had breakdowns in the first half allowing the Thunderbirds several easy layups.

"We were not aligned properly in our defense. We went in at halftime and showed them on the board," Bolla said. "We were running and chasing the ball rather than taking people in the lanes who were set. We were just out of sync."
