Students question the goodness of Good Friday

While most students were home preparing for the Easter weekend, nearly 100 members and guests of the InterVarsity Rebel Christian Fellowship spent Friday evening in the Moyer Student Union trying to answer the question, "What's so good about Good Friday?"

Friday's two-and-a-half-hour forum focused on examining what host Larry Thiel describes as historical Roman, Jewish and Christian accounts of the last days of Jesus of Nazareth.

Thiel, a graduate student in history and an InterVarsity Rebel Christian Fellowship adviser, says he likes to look at Easter through the eyes of a historian.

"Looking at religious events historically is one of many ways to investigate God's existence,"

Thiel said. "For me it's just more natural to look at them historically."

Presenting his case like a trial lawyer, Thiel read from what he called eyewitness historical accounts of the last days of Jesus of Nazareth by Roman and Jewish sources as well as religious writings by the apostles.

Shaking their heads in disbelief, the audience listened as Thiel graphically described the gruesome treatment received by Roman prisoners. At one point he even came forward, arms outstretched, to enact the crucifixion.

Thiel rounded out his speech with an explanation of some of the conflicting accounts of events after the crucifixion. "The resurrection cannot be proven 100 percent, but it is the most probable explanation (of the events)," he said.
