Increased emergency loans decrease number of borrowers

Until loans are paid back, students face collection agencies and registration holds.

In the past, the financial aid office has provided students with \$100 emergency loans.

Now the office has increased its limit to \$200 to provide additional help to student borrowers. But does the increase really benefit students?

Right now students cannot borrow money from the short term loan program because funds for the loan account are depleted. The account runs on a revolving funds basis and can only operate when loans are paid back. Over \$40,000 is still owed to

the emergency loan fund. "The purpose of the lcan is to help students in an emergency situation," Bursar Sharon Coomes said. "I feel the reason the money is drying up more quickly is the fact that the dollar

amount was increased to \$200. Before \$200 could be used to help two students, now it only helps

In other words, if students do not pay back the money borrowed within the 30-day time frame there is no money for other stu-

"In my opinion the money is going faster because of the increase in the amount of the loan," Coomes said. "It is easier for a student to come up with \$100 than \$200 in 30 days."

Financial Aid Director Judy Belanger defends the increase in the amount of the loans.

"What can you buy with \$100?" she said. "What we're trying to do is also increase the amount of money in the program so that it will not be depleted as quickly."

"Students sign an agreement when borrowing from the program that states the money, in addition to a \$1 fee for every

within 30 days.

Because students have not made it a priority to pay back the money, other students in need are having to go without the ser-

The new computer system being used is also contributing to the problem according Coomes.

"Even if the money is there, the new computer take longer to show that the money is in the account," Coomes said.

Financial aid is trying to remedy the problem.

"We turn the debts owed into collection agencies and a stu-

"Once loan is three years past due we write it off," Coomes said. "Last year we wrote off \$1,685 in outstanding emergency loans.
