toring at home," he said. "The School Refusal Clinic can arrange a part-time school program so that the child can gradually adjust to a school environment."

The difficult teenager, like a 13-year-old child, must be convinced to stay in school voluntarily. What often occurs is rebellion against the source of pressure.

In such a case the parents are advised to allow certain privileges if the teenager agrees to stay in school for the full day and do some chores. As a result there is less pressure from the parents and school seems like less of a burden. Character is built, and there is more of a sense of self-discipline instead of forced learning.

The School Refusal Clinic has research trailers located on campus next to the Thomas T. Beam Engineering Complex. It provides psychological counseling for children and parents with a series of simple tests to evaluate the severity of the situation.

Each individual case is carefully studied for causes, results, and possible solutions. The assessment process includes interviews for the child, whose progress is measured through a series of questionnaires and talks with the parents, school counselors, school nurses, teachers, and friends. Cooperation ensures success.

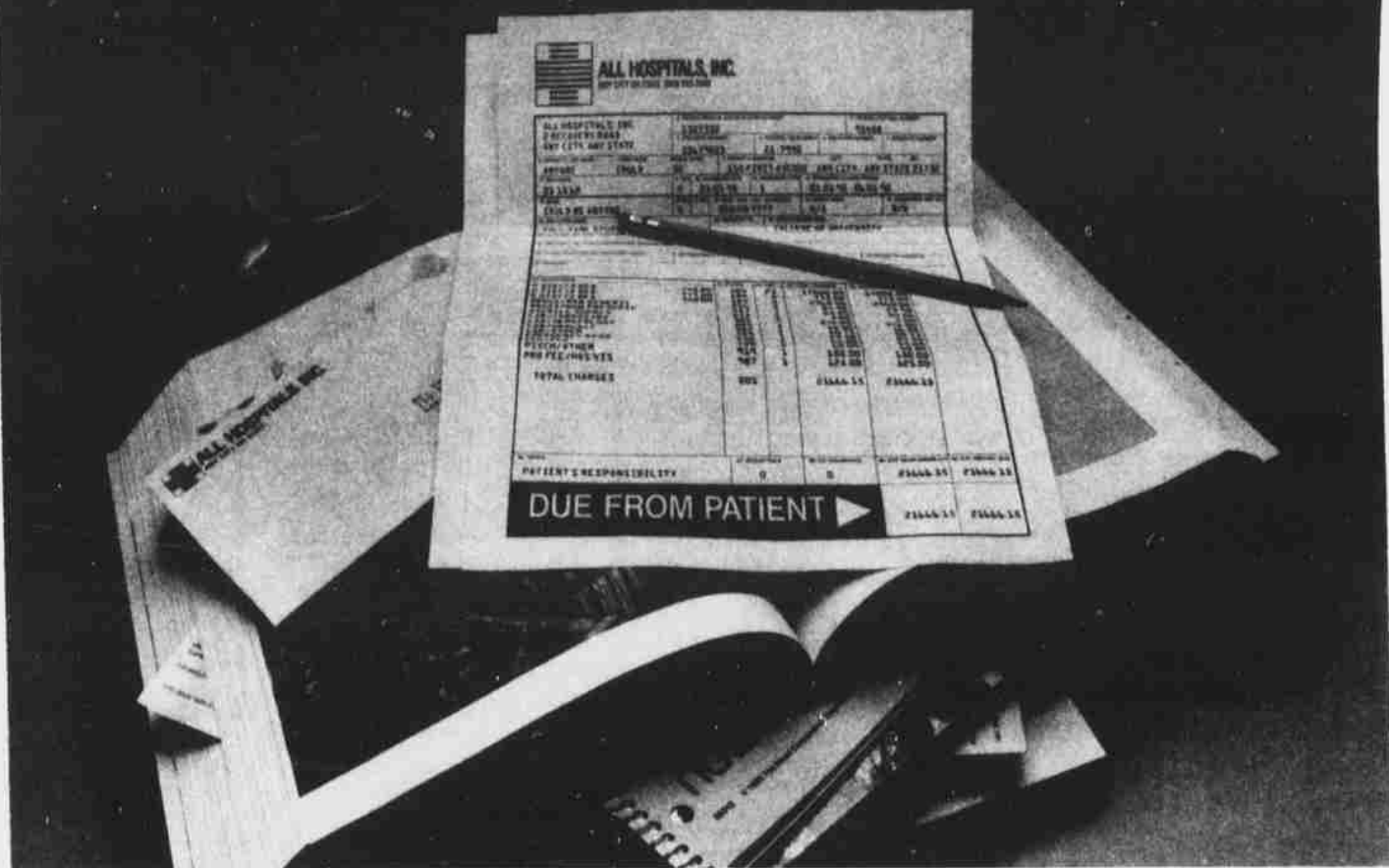
