Current architecture facilities inadequate

In reviewing UNLV's architecture program, John Jeronimo of the National Architectural Accrediting Board said, "the current facilities are not adequate for an accredited program."

Jeronimo said the time for UNLV's long-awaited accreditation will be up to the architec-

ture department.

"There is an effort to find an interim facility which would meet the (accreditation) needs," Jeronimo said, "even though (the facility) would be temporary."

In the accreditation team's last visit to UNLV, Jeronimo described the current facilities as "scattered."

"We happened to be there during a hail storm," he said. "You couldn't walk from one building to the other without getting wet.

We were therefore stranded in one building, even though the other building was only 20 feet away."

In addition to the architecture program's physical resources, the department, according to Jeronimo, will have to expand its academic resources in order to meet the growing enrollment.

Attention will be paid to the diversity of the faculty. Gender, race, and culture will be issues the

department will have to consider, Jeronimo said.

By reviewing the work of the students, the accreditation board will have a measuring stick with which to gauge the quality of the instructors.

"What we saw a year and a half ago seemed in terms of the quality of the faculty to be appropriate for a program that was just beginning. They are going to have to add some faculty," he said.

"We will be back this spring."
