

# Liberace Foundation awards UNLV music department \$7,500 grant

*\$365,000 will be awarded to 59 different schools including UNLV*

Earlier this month the Liberace Foundation for the Performing and Creative Arts awarded scholarship grants to 59 schools, among them the UNLV music department.

In a press release, Barbara Shaw, administrator of The Liberace Foundation, said, "This is the largest series of

grants and the most money awarded in the 17-year history of the foundation."

The grants for this year total \$365,000 and will be awarded to programs in theater, dance, music, costume design, fine art, and film making, Shaw said.

According to Ken Hanlon, associate professor of music, UNLV was one of the five original schools in the nation that began receiving the scholarships back in 1978.

This year, UNLV's allotment totaled \$7,500, a

slight decrease compared to the \$10,000 grants received in the past.

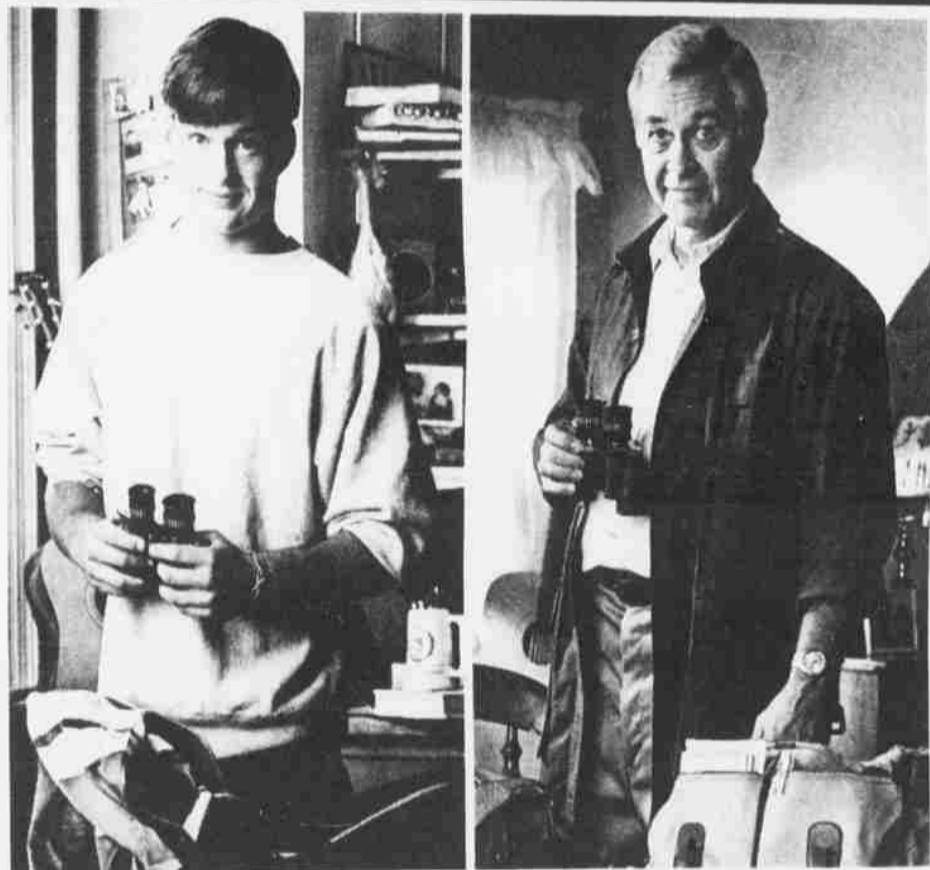
"I think this is either the first or second year we've dropped from \$10,000 to \$7,500," he said. "My understanding is that in recent years the amount of income that they're getting, as is the case with almost all foundations, has dropped, and with that so The Liberace Foundation is a non-profit organization created by the late entertainer in 1976 to provide scholarships for the arts.

university forward and enhancing its reputation by setting "academic excellence as the university's prime focus, although it might have been easier to continue to parlay the school's tremendous basketball success as a means of staying in the national spotlight."

"This is the biggest, single recognition of academics at UNLV," Maxson said.

Wilson writes that

UNLV's "exceptional leadership" has concentrated on building resources for teaching and learning, and he praises UNLV's programs in fields such as business, hotel administration, humanities, economics, education, and exercise physiology.

Along with statistical information, the section on UNLV includes interviews with three current students. With an initial print run of 20,000 copies, the book is circulated mainly on the East Coast and in the Midwest, Wilson said.
