Rhyme Cartel Records has nine new releases coming to record stores everywhere by artists E-Dawg, Sir Mix-A-Lot, Jay-Skee, Jazz Lee Alston, 3rd Level, and Kid Sensation.

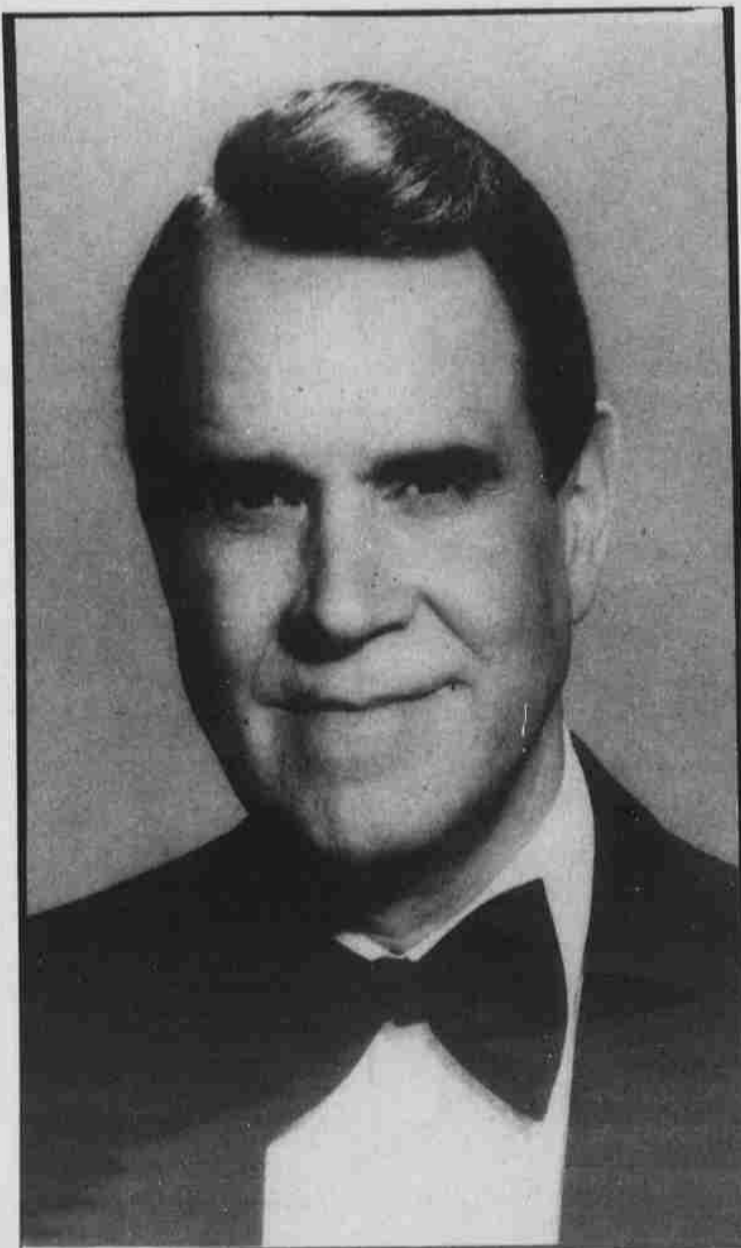

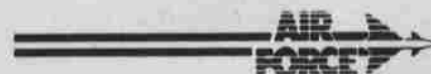
