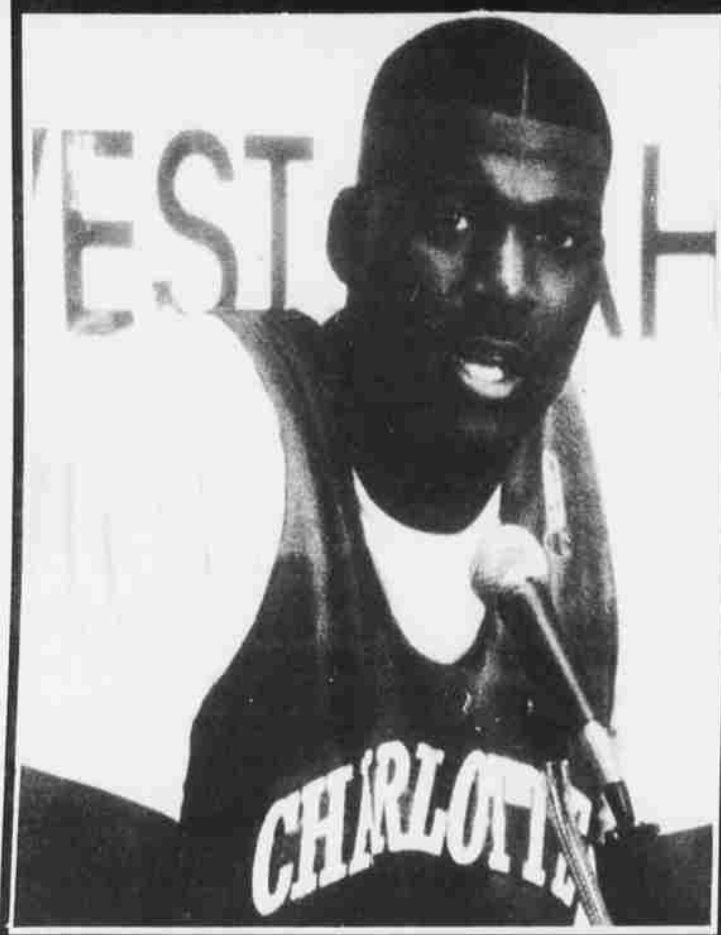


# LJ breaks the bank

the far post, 10 yards out. Noah Gins, a freshman midfielder, put a solid head on the ball only to have the Lobo keeper tip it off the crossbar.

The Lobos scored the game-winner with under a minute left in the half.

New Mexico's Mike Strati raced in on goal. As he approached the Rebel penalty area, UNLV freshman midfielder P.J. Roberts, who was marking Strati, tripped and fell toward the middle of the field. Strati tried to dribble to the left, but Roberts knocked the ball off Strati's shin and over to a wide open Joe Owen. He blasted a shot from the top left corner of the penalty area into the upper left corner of the net.

UNLV ended its losing streak at four matches and its scoreless string at two matches in their next game. It took two overtimes to get

the 2-1 win over Western Kentucky.

Down 1-0, senior forward Ben Erickson controlled the ball on the right wing and dribbled inside the penalty area where he touched it ahead to a wide open Roberts. He then drilled a shot from 10 yards out. It was saved by the Hilltoppers' keeper Lee Hunt. But he could not maintain control as the ball bounced to senior Rebel Danny Packer, who put it in the net.

The Rebels went into overtime for the first time this year. In the first minute of the second overtime period, freshman Noah Gins, lofted a pass down the left wing. Roberts hustled after the ball, beating Hunt and chipping it over his head into the net for the 2-1 victory.

The Rebels will resume Mountain Pacific Sports Federation play with UC Irvine, Friday at 7 p.m. The Rebels will then face defending Pacific Division champion UCLA Sunday at 2 p.m.

Four teams put their undefeated regular season records on the line Tuesday as the UNLV Intramurals volleyball playoffs opened at the South Gym.

In the Women's Division, Diggin' It (6-0) faced Latter Day Saints Student Association (4-2) in one semifinal and Island Girls (4-2) took on Zeta Tau Alpha (4-2) in the other semifinal.

The championship game will be played tonight at 7:30 p.m.

In the Men's Division, 13 teams competed in the first and quarterfinal rounds Tuesday.

The semifinals are at 8:30 p.m. followed by the championship game at 9:30 p.m. tonight.

The three 6-0 teams - Team FASA (Men's B), the Hawaiians (Men's A) and Sigma Chi (IFC) - received first round byes.

In addition to the undefeated teams, Tau Kappa Epsilon (5-1), Kappa Sigma (4-2) and Lambda Chi Alpha (3-3) qualified for the playoffs from the Intra-Fraternity Council Division.

In the Men's A Division, Orion (5-1), SPS (4-2) and the Bulldogs (3-3) clinched playoff berths while the Giants (5-1), Rodman 3 (3-3), Dig This (3-3), and Latter Day Saints Student Association (3-3) qualified from the Men's B Division.

... PBNJ won the Sports Officials Association Preseason Flag Football Tournament with a championship game forfeit win over Kappa Sigma on Saturday.

PBNJ defeated Tau Kappa Epsilon in the first round, the Wine Club in the quarterfinal and the Bulldogs in the semifinal.
