UNLV breaks even on latest road trip

The UNLV soccer team ended its longest road trip of the season with a victory at UC Irvine and a loss at No. 3 UCLA.

The 4-8 Rebels remain in the hunt for one of the two Pacific Division spots in the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation Tournament. However, they cannot afford another loss.

UNLV salvaged its first Federation win with a 2-0 triumph at UC Irvine Friday night. Rebel keeper Jeremy Angelo attained his second shutout of the season as UNLV defeated the host Anteaters for the 15th consecutive time.

With the Rebels up 1-0 after the first half, freshman midfielder Noah Gins, who acquired both assists in the game, brought the ball down the left wing and crossed to freshman midfielder P.J. Roberts. He raced in the final 30 yards for a one-on-one confrontation with the goalie. Roberts beat him to the right post and slipped it into the back of the net for insurance in the 2-0 win.

UNLV didn't fare as well against No. 3 UCLA on Sunday.

The Rebels packed it in defensively against the speedy Bruins and played counter soccer. But a defensive breakdown in the first half cost the Rebels. Rebel keeper Jeremy Angelo and midfielder Todd Huggins miscommunicated, resulting in a Bruin goal.

In the second half, UNLV kept its gameplan in perspective until the final minutes when it had to push forward for a goal, allowing the Bruins to break in on goal. UCLA scored with one minute remaining in the match. That goal secured the 2-0 victory for the Bruins, putting them atop the MPSF with a record of 3-0.
