No. 1 Swingin' Rebels finish below expectations at Jerry Pate

The Rebel golf team finished in unfamiliar territory as they captured 10th place overall at the Jerry Pate National Collegiate Tourney in Birmingham, Ala.

The No. 1 ranked Rebels finished the tourney with 884 total points. Wake Forest won the tournament with a total of 867.

The highest Rebel to finish in the individual standings was Chris Riley, who finished fourth with a three round total of 214. He was two strokes ahead of the winner, Ron Whittaker of Wake Forest who ended the three rounds at 212.

Riley had come off four tournament showings where he did not finish below second place.

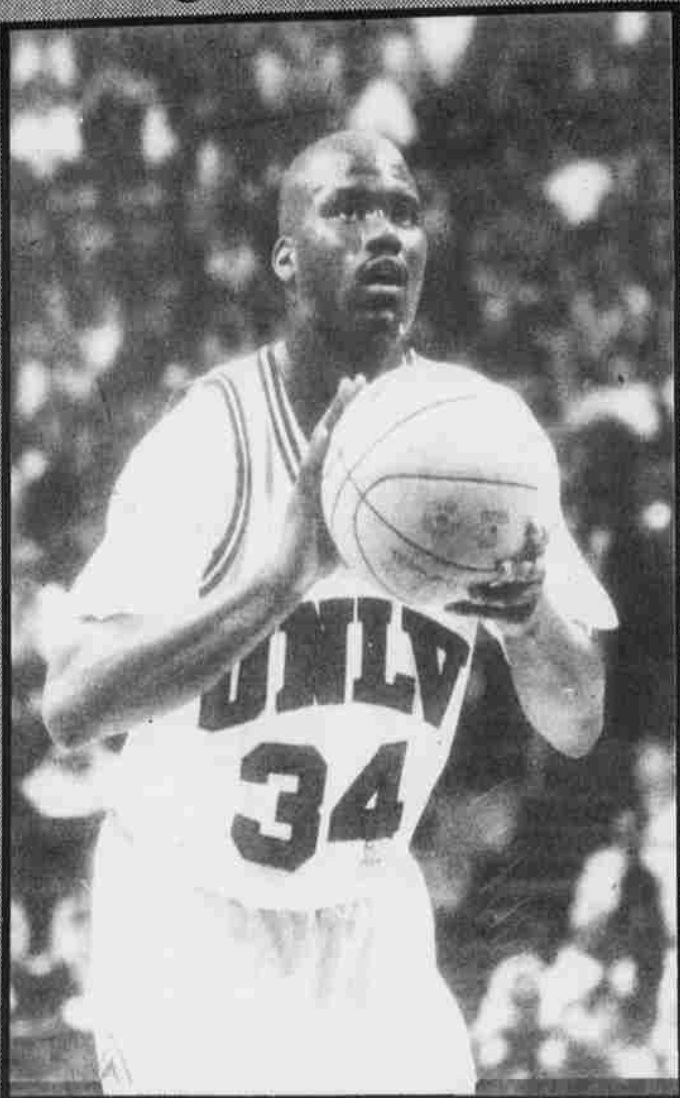
Gilberto Morales finished 31st with a score of 223. Senior Ed Fryatt tied with four others at 225 to take 37th place overall.

Rebels close season on road

The end has come.

The UNLV soccer team will play its final two matches Friday and Sunday.

St. Mary's of the West Coast Conference will be their first obstacle in the conclusion of this rebuilding season. UNLV will try to improve its 6-9-1 record Friday at Silvio Garaventa Field.

The Rebels lead the all-time series with a perfect 4-0 record against the Gaels, with all four victories being shutouts. St. Mary's has had an up-and-down season this year, coming into the game at 6-9-0 overall.

On Sunday, UNLV will battle the Golden Bears of California (5-10-2). The Rebels will close out the season on AstroTurf for the first time. The Bears post a 4-1-1 record and lead the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation Mountain Division. Cal has been extremely tough at home this season as the Golden Bears are the only team in the MPSF to play on artificial turf. UNLV hasn't played on AstroTurf since the beginning of the 1992 season at North Texas and at Southern Methodist.

UNLV is 2-0-1 against California. The tie came last year when the Rebels blew a 2-0 lead with 10 minutes remaining in regulation. The schools first met in 1982 with UNLV winning 3-2.

Lady Rebels at conference meet

The Lady Rebel cross country team is in California this weekend to compete in the Big West Conference Championships.

Cal State Fullerton is hosting the meet that will mark the 11th anniversary of the women's race. The 5-kilometer women's run will be held at Carbon Canyon Regional Park Saturday at 10:30 a.m. Defending champion UC

Irvine is again the favorite, having won the team title nine of the previous 10 times.

UNLV finished in eighth place a year ago and has not finished higher than that since a fourth place showing in 1987.

No Lady Rebel runner has finished in the top ten since Helen Reluga's eighth place finish in 1985.
