continued from 1 Weaver said, "or my recommendation to hire or not hire."

Weaver said he shied away from recommending Grgurich as coach because of concerns with who he wanted to bring back as assistants, the fact Weaver did not have a comfort zone throughout the course of the Monday and Tuesday meetings, and concerns over the perception of the Tarkanian issue.

"If those three types of issues are out there," Weaver said. "It's moving too fast.

"I wasn't comfortable making a recommendation to Dr. Guinn that Tim Grgurich should be the coach at UNLV today," Weaver said. "That's not to say that Tim Grgurich might not be the best candidate to be the coach three, four or five months from now. And if that's what this university decides, then so be it. I don't have a problem."

Weaver said it was image problems that prompted his decision.

"It appears to me that I need to step aside, because I am part of the old; I am perceived as being part of the problem. And whether that's actual or not, perception is reality in our business of intercollegiate athletics. I believe very strongly in this university and the community and I want to do what's best for both of those entities and that is the precipitating cause of my action."

"And if I am correct in assuming that I am part of that tag, of the old, I want to remove myself, so that this university and this community can start to heal and

move back towards a state of normalcy."

Guinn warned that if the community reacted in an adverse manner, he too, would take drastic action.

"We're going to move slowly, and we'regoing to try to do what's best," he said. "If that decision is not what's best for this community, then I too, will turn in my resignation."
