continued from 13 to the all-Big West first team and needs only eight steals to become the school's all-time leader.

Tracy Titus, 14.9 ppg and 9.2 rbg, was named to the all-Big West second team and scored in double figures in 19 of 25 games off the bench.

Summer Peterson, 6.4 ppg and 3.8 rpg, was named to the freshman team. She hauled down 11 rebounds against Hawaii.

UNLV finished the regular season with four starters averaging double figures: Angie White 11.7, LeAnn Kazmer 11.4, Hobbs and Titus.

Should the Lady Rebels advance past Pacific, they will likely face No. 1 seed New

Mexico State with 5-11 junior forward Anita Maxwell, who won her second consecutive Big West Player of the Year award. Both teams also split their two meetings, with the Lady Rebels winning the first, 74-68, and then losing at home, 60-57.

An anticipated key matchup features Peterson and Titus battling in the post against Maxwell.

"We can't stand around and let her shoot in her range without challenging the shot," said Bolla of his probable matchup. "She's deadly in the range of ten feet. Which is why our rotation to the ball has to be effective. We can't afford to be a second late to the ball, so we had better anticipate and force them into bad shot selections."

Closing With a Flourish

The UNLV women's basketball team closed the regular season with a pair of road wins to give the Lady Rebels the No. 5 seed in this week's Big West Tournament.

On March 2, the Lady Rebels (11-14, 10-8) spoiled UC Santa Barbara's Senior Night with a 76-68 win behind sophomore guard Angie White's 22 points (five 3-pointers). Both are career-highs for White.

The visitors opened up a 19-6 lead while the Lady Gauchos struggled offensively. The hosts managed to close the lead to 38-34 at the half. UCSB (13-5, 17-8) center Amy Smith paced their effort with 22 points.

Summer Peterson (14 points in 20 minutes) and LeAnn Kazmer (11 points) each finished in double figures in scoring with Gwynn Hobbs and Tracy Titus each adding nine points. Hobbs also had a career-high 13 assists.

Hobbs led the Lady Rebels in scoring with 22 points, 11 assists and nine rebounds while Titus contributed 17 off the bench.

The Lady 49ers fed off senior forward Melissa Gower's 36 points but gagged on 21 turnovers. UNLV helped its cause by limiting its miscues to 14.

"We were very fortunate to escape with the win against Long Beach," senior Celeste Robinson said. "I hope we learn to put teams away early in the Big West tourney by playing two solid halves. I'm just glad we won and I know we can carry this momentum into the tournament."

The Lady Rebels finished the season by winning four of their last five games.
