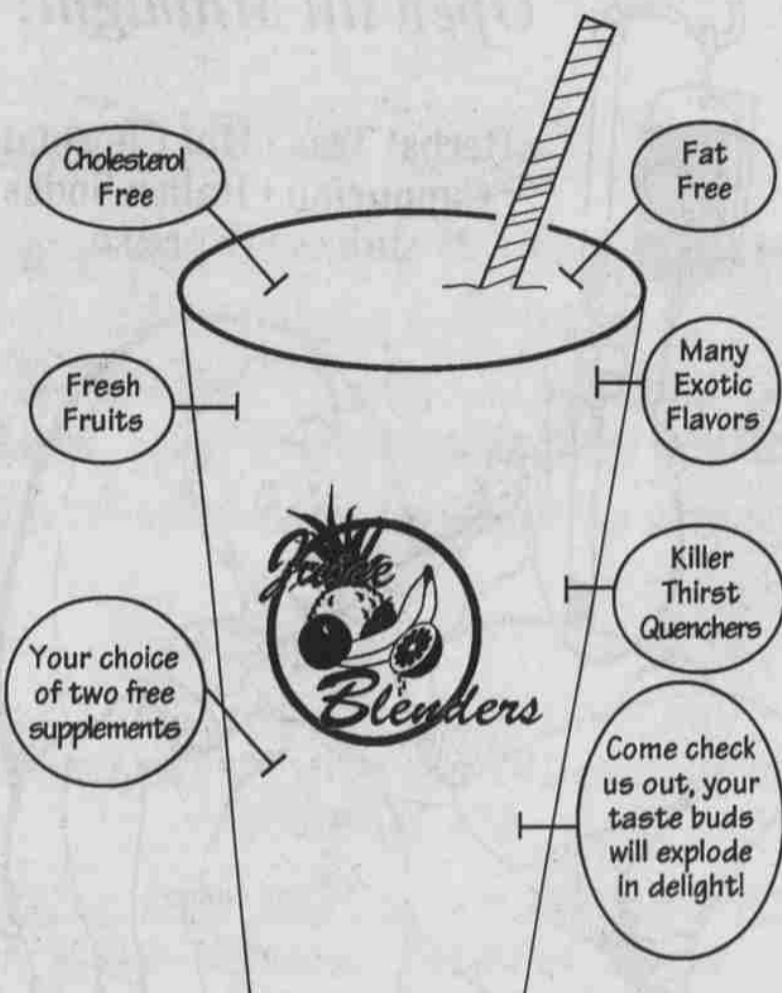

Swingin' Rebels reach No. 3, finish at No. 7

Most of the season it seemed like a one-man show for the UNLV Golf team with junior Chris Riley running the show.

The Rebels, who were ranked as high as No. 3 during the season finally fell into the No. 7 spot toward the end of the season.

In mid-May the Rebels played in the NCAA West Regional where they placed fifth amongst 18 teams. The Rebels have never finished out of the top five in the Regional tournament in its seven year history.

From there they played in the NCAA Championships where they did not fare as well. They finished 15th in the tournament and for the fifth straight season they finished in the top 15 in the championship tournament.

The Rebels captured three tournament titles during the season and finished within the top five 10 times.

Riley was named Big West Golfer of the Year as well as UNLV Olympic Sportsman of the Year. He also picked up second team All-America honors for his big season.

A wide variety of sports and recreational opportunities are offered, including everything from basketball to wallyball. Sporting equipment is also available for a rental fee.

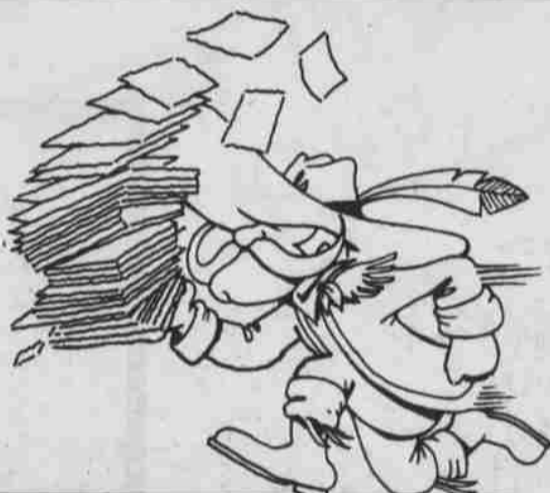

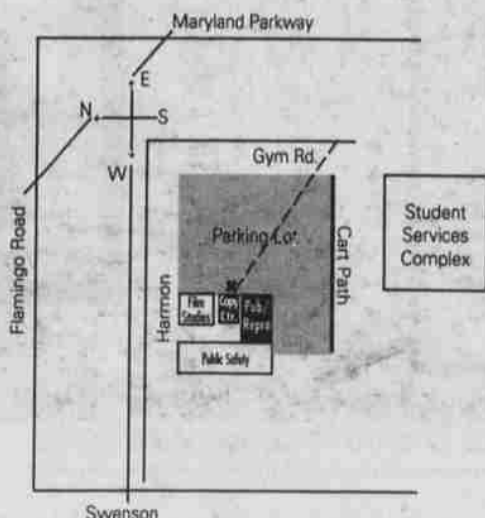

outright BigWest Championship for the team.

Individual accomplishments include several gathered by senior first baseman Cyndi Parus, where she had the most doubles (39), RBI's (136), walks (63) and game winning RBI's (33) in a career. She was also named to the first team All-America team along with sophomore shortstop Kim Rondina.

Rondina capped off an impressive season by setting the records for best season batting average (.436) and home runs (15). She also had the seventh longest hitting streak in NCAA history, hitting safely in 21 straight games.

Rondina also came out of the season with the Big West Conference Field Player of the Year, while Coach Shan McDonald was named West Region Coach of the Year.

Amie Stewart also completed a strong senior season as the Lady Rebel pitcher. She led the Rebel pitching with a 1.40 ERA and a 30-9 record, which was the most in her career. She also set the school record for saves with 11 in her career and was named to the second team All-America team.

Also receiving All-American honors was junior center fielder Sara Mallett, who was named to the second team, and freshman catcher Julie Crandall, who was named to the third team.
