**Organization deadline approaching**

The student government's Organization Board has announced a Sunday deadline for campus student organizations.

The student government requires all student organizations to complete recognition packets and provide the following information:

- A copy of the organization's constitution and bylaws ratified within the last two years,
- A non-discriminatory statement signed and dated by the organization's president,
- A grade verification form and membership roster,
- Name two organization representatives to the student government Organization Board and
- Name a faculty adviser and provide proper verification.

The Organization Board requires its members to present their student identification at its meetings to ensure the appropriate representative is present. Voting placards will only be given to recognized representatives.

Recognition packets are available in the student government office. New organizations are advised to make an appointment with Organization Board Director Toby Cole.

**CSUN candidate filing date posted**

The student government has posted 5 p.m., Sept. 15 as the official filing deadline for CSUN elected positions.

The student government requires filing packets to be completed and the following fees paid:

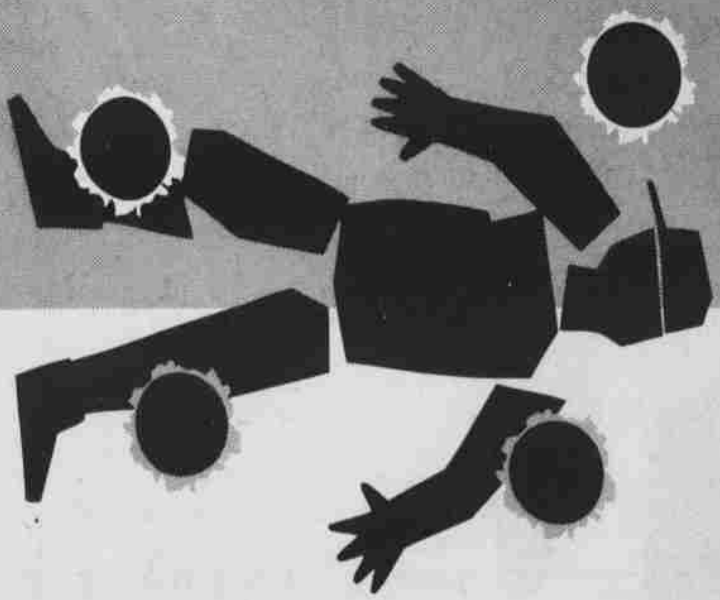
- \$25 for all Senate candidates,
- \$30 for all Homecoming candidates and
- \$20 for *The Rebel Yell* Advisory Board candidates.

In addition, candidates are required to attend a mandatory 5:30 p.m., Sept. 15 in the MSU (room to be announced). Campaigning officially starts after this meeting.

The student government has advised that any preliminary campaigning will result in disqualification. Elections for Senate and *The Rebel Yell* Advisory Board positions will be held Thursday and Friday, Oct. 5-6. The Homecoming election will be held Wednesday and Thursday, Oct. 25-26.
