Kelepecz has been with the company since its inception, and her credits include the Los Angeles Ballet, the Zurich Opera Ballet, the Houston Ballet, and principal dancer at the famed Lido show at the Stardust Hotel.

Kirk Offerle, associate director, is leading the 16-member cast in rehearsals for its first performance, "OPUS 19: A Tribute To Ginger Rogers." Offerle spent nine years working in dance, television and choreography in Italy. He has lived in Las Vegas for two months, and said "Las Vegas, UNLV and OPUS are great outlets for me. This is the best place to be in the United States for dancers."
