Of particular importance, though, is how the professor's frustration with the atmosphere of political correctness and with the impending charges caused him to violently overreact. Although his actions are unconscionable, they do serve to point out the possible dangers involved with the irresponsible manipulation of our current atmosphere of social tolerance. This play reminds us that while political correctness is vital to a diverse society, it must never be used without some sense of proportion if it is to survive at all.
