Disneyland of the world for adults to a dump site? I don't think so."

Titus added that it is unfair for Nevada to store waste that was made elsewhere.

"I think it's being done for political reasons, not scientific, and that's the tragedy," said Titus, a native of Georgia.

According to Titus, crime will always be a big problem unless more money is spent to prevent it.

Speaking of the "Truth In Sentencing" legislation that was passed in the last Legislative session, Titus said, "What worries me is that it does nothing to deal with the

causes of crime. It just cures the symptoms."

The measure was passed to ensure that criminals will serve a standard minimum amount of time of their sentences.

According to Titus, the massive influx of senior citizens to Las Vegas is one reason it's so difficult to pass school bond issues.

"They (senior citizens) certainly want to keep taxes low because they're on a fixed income and they figure they've already paid their taxes somewhere else," Titus said. "They don't want to pay them now, and they don't have any children in school."

Titus, who is up for re-election in 1996, said that she does not plan to run for Congress in the next election. She added however, that it may be a possibility in 1998.

"Never say never," she said.
