Students plant trees in wildlife refuge

UNLV's Environmental Studies Program and Students Conscious of Protecting the Environment will sponsor a tree planting in the Ash Meadows Wildlife Refuge on Tuesday.

The refuge is located just north of Pahrump where there are 24 plants and animals to be found that don't exist anywhere else in the world.

The tree planting is the last step in a project that was started this year to remove a human dwelling from the refuge. Prior to 1984, a couple was illegally living on the refuge, and the Fish and Wildlife Department bulldozed the dwelling following the couple's death.


On Oct. 21, SCOPE cleaned up the refuge, and helped the wildlife biologist do a final cleanup and removal of debris from the site.

Tuesday's tree planting is part of the plan to plant more than 200 mesquite trees to return the site to a natural habitat for the protected species.

"When the trees are planted, it will look like it was never a human dwelling," said Tara Pike, UNLV coordinator of environmental affairs.
