results of our monitoring will be available soon," says Simon.

Student response to the extended library hours has been positive.

"Most students attending the university have weird schedules," said senior physics student Michael Bright. "Since Vegas is a 24-hour town, it's good to see the library open longer to accommodate more people."

"It's nice to know that if I do need to use the library late on the weekend, I will have that resource available," said Jane Confrey, a junior majoring in engineering.

Additional full-time library employees will be hired to provide a consistent level of service to students using the library during extended evening hours, according to Simon.

Extended hours isn't the only change being made to UNLV's library. One thousand new periodical subscriptions will be added to the library, while the reserve collection will be digitized. These additions will allow students to access works on reserve through computer.

Officials will begin working on implementing these changes this summer, though it may take several years to do so because of copyright and technical problems.

Plans for a new library, at the corner of Gym Road and Harmon Avenue, are due to be completed this summer. The anticipated completion of the new library is 1999.
