An example of this would be the UNR game. The Rebels were able to control the tempo of the first half, holding the Pack to just 21. Once the second half got underway, though, the Rebels found themselves floundering against the inside presence of Daniel Watts and Dallas Spears. Watts lit up the Rebels for 25 points and nine boards.

With the addition of Clark next season, and also highly-touted Isaiah Epps, look for Corbett to be gone next season, and Lane pushed down to third string.

The guards for the Rebels this season have been adequate, with the only consistency coming from "Sunshine," who is averaging 12.4 points-per-game.

The point is a whole different story. It has been point guard by committee, and Bayno is still looking for a

chairman.

For the most part it has been Kevin James, backed by Chancellor Davis and Ben Sanders. But lately, Bayno has been experimenting with different looks, and Sanders has found himself running the show more than a few times.

Has it worked? The jury is still out.

Coming in next season will be Donovan Stewart, though, and he will be groomed as the point for the future. Early reports from a variety of sources have said that this kid could be another Greg Anthony, something that will make Bayno happy.

If he is as good as he sounds, Davis and James will be looking for new positions.

The Rebels will have Rosegreen, "Sunshine" and Lane will definitely be back next season, but how about the rest of the club? Johnson is a senior and will graduate this year, as well as Wes Reed (although he doesn't get much playing time to begin with).

But how about some of the other role-players, like Grant Rice and Reed Berglund? Well, with three scholarships still open, Bayno is going to have to break some bad news to a few kids.

Next year is going to be a mirror-image of this season, with new faces aplenty running the floors in the house that Tark built. But will it be better than the past few years? Let's hope so.
