## **Complaints filed in** student body election

Smith, Moore, and Fleischman accused of unfair practices

Senate President Pat Smith, Senate President Pro-tempore Terry Moore, and College of Education Senator Leia Fleischman have been accused of removing campaign fliers of their opposing candidates in conjunction with the CSUN Executive Board General Election.

Senior Scott Schwartz, hotel administration, filed a complaint with Elections Board Director Stephanie Araiza, alleging Smith and Moore removed many of his campaign fliers and replaced them with theirs (Smith's and Moore's). Schwartz is running for student government president.

"I'm sure this was a deliberate act to hurt my campaign," Schwartz said. "Over 50 percent of my fliers were removed. That's much more than is normal for an election."

Smith and Moore deny Schwartz's allegations.

Moore, a junior environmen-

tal studies major, said, "I have no idea where he's (Schwartz) getting this," Moore said Mon-day. "Everybody gets some fliers removed during any election, including me, but I never took down someone else's.

"All he (Schwartz) has is circumstantial evidence, because I didn't do it," Moore added.

Smith agreed. "I didn't get to read the complaint (filed by Schwartz), but from what I've heard it's absolutely ridiculous," Smith said.

"I'm not even running against him," said Smith, who will attempt to retain his Senate presidency. "I don't care for him (Schwartz), but I wouldn't tear down his fliers.

"This is the fourth executive board election I've seen and I know the rules," Smith added. Schwartz said the amount

of missing fliers was excessive. "This is the worst election I've ever been a part of."

Joe Mills, student government vice president, alleges similar activities and has also filed complaints, one against Moore and one against Fleischman, who is running for student government president.

"This was a blatant act," said Mills. "I could see it happening once or twice, but 472 fliers were removed.

Araiza was not available for comment

The elections board will determine the validity of each complaint
