next season, it will be a sort of deja vu for Rebel fans as they see former Rebel coach, Jerry Tarkanian, suck on a towel on the FSU side of the court.

Tarkanian is the winningest coach in college history (by percentage), and spent 19 years at the helm of the Runnin' Rebels, including a national championship in 1990.

Another big adjustment for the Runnin' Rebels when they enter the WAC will be the tough travel schedule the team will face. Going

from Colorado State to Wyoming to Fresno State, the Rebels will have to fight harder for those type of wins than they have had to against the BWC.

"The travel schedule and the altitude I think make it the toughest road league in the country," UNLV head coach Bill Bayno ex-

plained. "One, you're flying season in the BWC, and had from great distances, and two, you're playing at high levels of altitudes.

"It's going to be tough," Bayno continued. "The WAC makes for a much tougher schedule. There are higher

Mallett added to her hitting onslaught, going 1-for-3 with a double, one RBI and one run

Right fielder Ronnie Salcido had two hits and two RBIs to pace the Rebels in the victory in the first game.

In the second game against the Aggies, the Rebels played like a completely different team. With holes in the defense and the pitching, the Rebels suffered a rare defeat at the hands of Big West Conference rival Aggies. First-team All-American

Kim Rondina committed two errors in the defeat. Rondina, the Big West Conference Field Player of the Year last season, has already committed 15 errors this season.

Edwards was shelled, giv-ing up 12 hits and six runs, while falling to 9-3 for the sea-

The usual hitting dominance of the Rebels was not

effective, as the Rebels stranded 12 runners on base, and only scored three runs.

The Rebels did come out of the gates hot, with Mallett leading off the game with a double and scoring on a Rondina triple. Rondina later scored on a Heather Siegal single to right field.

The Aggies did their damage in the top half of the third, when they had three singles, which led to three runs. Heather Markowitz let one go through her legs on a grounder to third, opening the flood gates for the Aggies in their three-run third inning.

Despite a Markowitz RBI single in the fifth, the Rebels found themselves too far behind, and were never able to catch up.

After seeing their winning streak snapped at three games, the Rebels bounced back Saturday to defeat Utah State 6-2.

Mallett went 2-for-3 with three runs and one stolen base to lead the Rebels on offense.

Branch hurled her third win in as many days, and second win in two days against the Aggies, by throwing six strikeouts and going the distance for her seventh win of the sea-

In the last game of the sixgame home stand, the Rebels defeated the Aggies again, 3-

Siegal had a two-run double in the fourth inning, and Salcido had an RBI single and two stolen bases to lead UNLV.

Edwards avenged her dismal performance, throwing five strikeouts and only giving up two late-inning runs.

Crandall went 2-for-4 with a double and a single, and Mallett had her hitting streak halted, going 0-for-4.

The Rebels host the University of Missouri for two games on Wednesday, beginning at noon.

They hold a 2-0 edge lifetime record against the Big Eight Conference Tigers, winning their only two contest in the 1992 season.
