Kari Borra, a junior hotel administration major and Allison's classmate, said, "Seeing her picture on the news really hit home."

"She had everything going for her. It's the saddest thing."

"She was such a young, beautiful girl," said Sonny Loftin, Liberty justice of the peace. "The whole town wants to get it straight. You don't expect that out here. That's why people move to the country."

Allison's funeral services were held in Texas Saturday.

electrical systems are interdependent.


The problem was not caused by the building's age, Amend said, but usage changes such as additional computer labs contributed to the power outage.
