

### Pope's Message

(Continued from Page 1) Schmidt said he had the following statement to make on behalf of Cardinal Bea:

"For an interpretation of the Holy Father's Passion Sunday homily, it is essential to keep in mind that the Pope was speaking to ordin-

ary and simple faithful people - not before a learned body -- and so he did not use any specific theological, if you like, technical language. Therefore his words cannot be interpreted in the same strict way in which a conciliary document is and must be interpreted. A conciliary document is very precise. You cannot repeat in a sim-

ple sermon. So, an honest interpretation of the Holy Father's homily cannot be interpreted in the same manner that you would interpret a conciliary document."

At the same time he reiterated a recent Cardinal Bea assertion in Rome that the declaration exonerated Jews of the deicide charge was "still in the hands of the Secretariat." Cardinal Bea is president of the Vatican Secretariat for Christian unity and has been one of the prime movers of such a declaration. At the same time, Rev. Schmidt admitted that there was still some opposition among Catholic prelates to a proposed declaration on relations with non-Christians, but that most prelates, he said, are fearful that "the declaration will be abused so as to encourage and strengthen Israel and lead the Holy See to recognize Israel" even though "Cardinal Bea has declared openly in the Council wide that the declaration is not political but theological."

The Pope's Passion Sunday homily on Jewish guilt in the crucifixion, coupled with reports that conservative and near East prelates in Rome were gaining ascendancy in a move to dilute the proposed Vatican Council declaration on Jews, triggered deep concern among Jewish groups who felt that just as adoption of such a statement would be a most potent instrument in promoting Catholic-Jewish relations, so rejection of the move would only undermine existing interfaith relations.

Professor Abraham J. Heschel, one of the leading Jewish figures in the effort to secure a Vatican Council declaration clearing Jews of the crime of crucifixion, called the deicide charge "the most dreadful calumny ever uttered".
