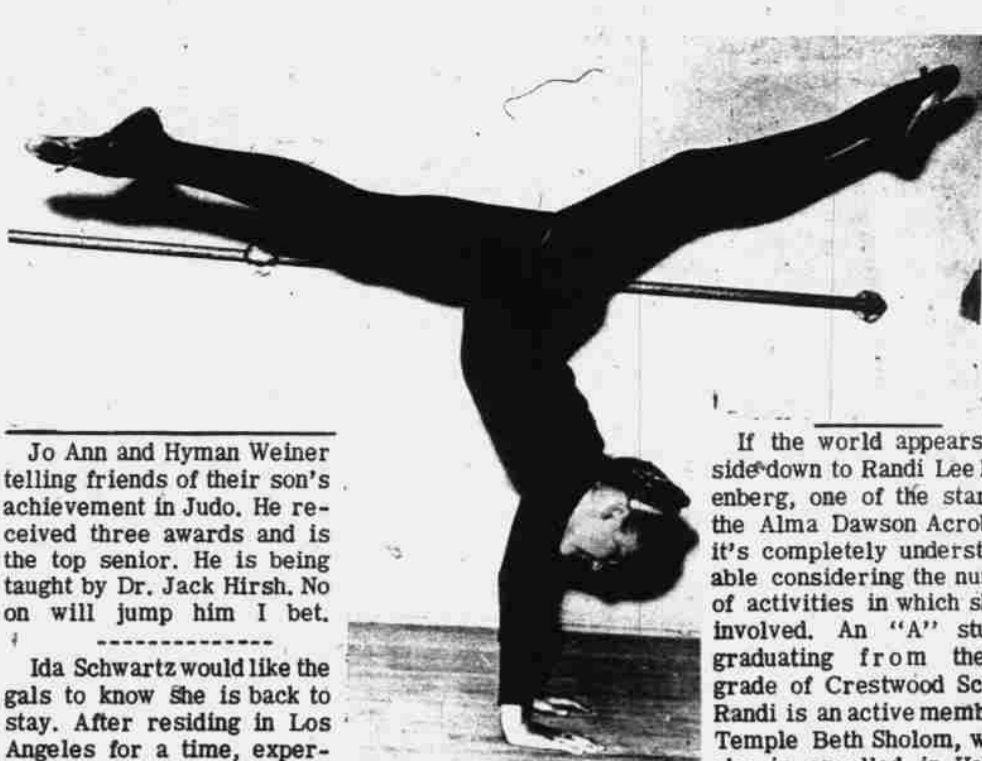
Belated congratulations to the Heplers on the Bar Mitzvah of their son.
