

SAWYER SEEKS HONOR YOUTHS

Nominees for the awards of the Young American Medals for Bravery and Service are being sought by Gov. Grant Sawyer.

The medals, awarded annually by the U. S. Attorney General, go to young people who have performed acts of extraordinary courage or who have achieved an outstanding record of ser-

vice to their communities. Federal regulations provide that nominations must be made by state governors.

"I am sure there are many young people throughout Nevada whose heroism and devotion to others deserve the widest recognition," the governor said. "I hope the people of Nevada will bring their exploits to public attention."

Nominees must have performed their acts of bravery or service during 1964 and before their 19th birthday. Persons knowing of someone worthy of recognition are asked to write Sawyer in Carson City.

Awards for bravery in 1963 went to a seven-year-old girl who lost her life getting her tiny brother out of a burning house, a 13-year-old boy who twice descended into a noxious, abandoned cesspool to rescue a two-year-old child and a 16-year-old girl who ran back into the family's burning home to protect her invalid grandmother.

An award for service was granted to an 18-year-old who organized his friends into a volunteer remedial reading school for Puerto Rican and Negro children in Spanish Harlem.

Featuring a leading Jewish, Protestant and Catholic educator in a panel presentation of "Our Answer to the Challenge of Youth," the joint convention of the United Synagogue of America and National Federation of Jewish Men's Clubs will evaluate the three faiths' approaches to maintaining and stimulating religious interest and activity by their young people.
