Cantorial Notes

The Mystique

Naming Jewish music is as difficult as naming American music. It is selected; a composite of influences worldwide in scope and idiom. It is like the recent cartoon in the New Yorker depicting a Russian Gypsy Violinist playing to embracing couples and the waiter saying: "You're in great form, Luigi." Two Cantors, Richard Tucker and Jan Peerce are two of the finest Italian singers today. A great cantor is an artist dedicated to worship.

True Jewish music comes from the tradition and soil, reflecting the soul of a people. In the Cantorial, it is free flights of the imagination rooted in phrases from time immemorial, orally transmitted defying exact rotation. The terms secular and sacred could classify Eli Eli and Kolnidrey, Mickey Katz, American Jewish satire, is the unsophisticated Americanized version of a blend of all folk styles.

The Russian composer Prokofiev wrote an "Overture on Hebrew Themes." It is a hodge-podge completely unauthentic. The Schelons (Solomon) of Ernst Bloch is a vast orchestral rhapsody capturing at times the rare quality of the gorgeousness

of Jewish History Tragedy and Lore. But his sacred service is better in English.

The music of Max Helfman great interpreter who has holoms, tried to be authentic, but Max, who I worked with personally failed. He attempted the musicological approach, only producing artificial flowers. Taking the best that had been written and sung, music cannot be produced, it must be spontaneously created by a human enraptured by the meaning of the text of what he is singing. For example: El Mah Rachermian, the most touching I have ever heard have been sung by our own Cantor Kohn; yet he rarely sings it twice the same way. Why? Because he feels it differently each time.

To sum up, Jewish music is rare in individuals of genius, and certain traditional masterpieces that time has proved indestructibly great the interpreter adds himself and God speaks through him.
