

**JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS**

NEW YORK (WNS) Vice President Hubert H. Humphrey will be the guest speaker at the annual dinner of the Weizmann Institute of Science on December 6th at the Waldorf-Astoria.

JERUSALEM (WNS) Hungarian newspaper charges that Dr. Alexander Toerock, counsellor to the West German Embassy in Tel Aviv, had been a member of the Hungarian Nazi Party, are to be investigated by the Israeli legation in Budapest, it was disclosed by the Israel Foreign Ministry.

Dr. Toerock has denied the charges and been defended by the West German Government, but the evening newspaper Yediot Achronoth reported this week on the basis of a telephone conversation with the Hungarian Jewish historian Jano Libal that the West German diplomat had in fact been a member of the Arrow Cross, the Hungarian Nazi Party.

WASHINGTON (WNS) A number of members of both houses of Congress urged the Johnson Administration not to resume aid to Egypt until it has met certain conditions, such as readiness to stop the arms race and cease fomenting trouble in the Middle East.

The lawmakers made their views known against the background of disclosure that the State Department had urged renewal of large-scale shipment of surplus commodities to Egypt.

NEW YORK (WNS) Reports of two anti-Semitic incidents in Hungary, one in Budapest and the other in the village of Balaton Boglar, reached here from reliable sources abroad. The Budapest incident involved smearing of a swastika on the walls of the Jewish Community Center. In the village of Balaton Boglar, the target was the Jewish cemetery, where thirty tombstones were found to have been broken.

SYDNEY (WNS) A by-election in Bondi sent to Parliament one of the leading Jewish figures here, Sydney D. Einfeld, who ran on the Labor Party ticket.

NEW YORK (WNS) The Jewish community of Aden, which numbered about 7,000 in 1947, is now down to 400, it was disclosed here by the World Jewish Congress on the basis of information it received from Entob Messa, leader of the Aden Jewish Community.

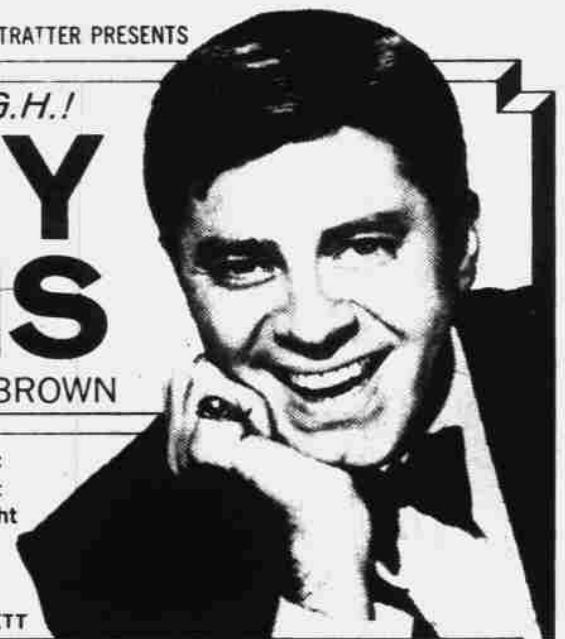
