stint with Uncle Sam, he took himself to the Southern College of Optometry in Memphis. He graduated in 1962. His internship was spent with two men, one dealing only in Contact Lenses, and the other in the field of Visual Aid, spending six months with each.

Being a young man with a keen sense of progress and a clearer vision of what the future can be for those in his field, he decided that the chances back East were badly hindered by over-crowded conditions. 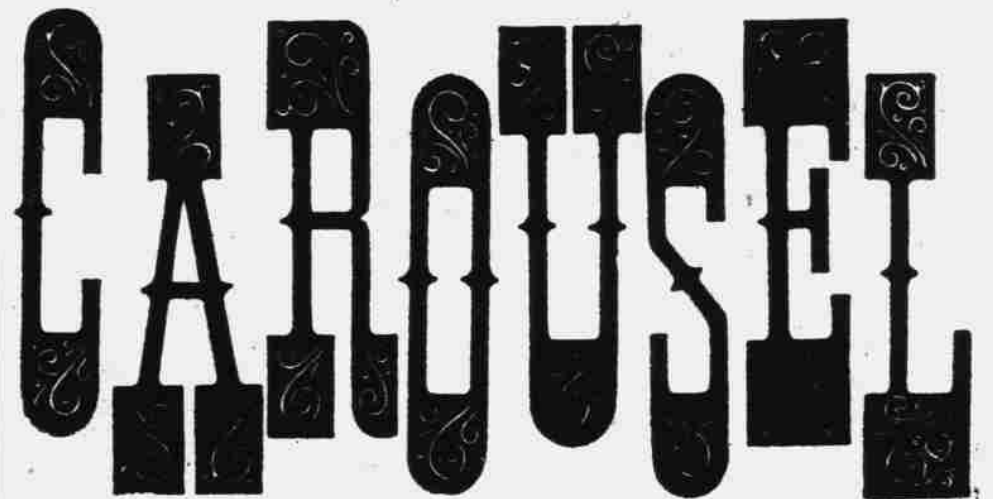
