

**JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS**

**JERUSALEM (WNS)** Premier Levi Eshkol, suffering from what his doctors called "general exhaustion," has been hospitalized and ordered to rest for ten days.

**NEW YORK (WNS)** Three top World War II military leaders, among them former President Dwight D. Eisenhower, was honored at the 28th Annual Conference of the United Jewish Appeal for having "won deliverance of all people from Nazi bondage." The other two are Great Britain's Field Marshall, the Earl Alexander of Tunis, and General Pierre Koenig, Commander-in-Chief of the Free French Forces. Receiving the medal for General Eisenhower, who is convalescing, will be his old friend and associate General Lucius D. Clay, former Commander-in-Chief of the U.S. Armed Forces in Europe.

**NEW YORK (WNS)** Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., on being presented here with the Judaism and World Peace Award of the Synagogue Council of America, warned against the peril of escalation, declaring that "those who would question it as a policy are being subjected to intensified attack." Presentation of the award was made by Dr. Abraham Joshua Heschel, professor of Jewish ethics and mysticism at the Jewish Theological Seminary.

**DETROIT (WNS)** A teenage hate club here was broken up by the police, who held seven of the youngsters on twenty-nine charges. The club, according to the police, aped the Ku Klux Klan with hatred against Jews and Negroes. The 15-year-old leader of the gang called himself Imperial Wizard.

**NEW YORK --** Rabbi Selwyn D. Ruslander, spiritual leader of Temple Israel, Dayton, Ohio, was installed as chairman of the National Jewish Welfare Board Commission on Jewish Chaplaincy.

**WASHINGTON (WNS)** The Administration's decision to resume aid to Egypt was clarified here this week by a high White House official who said that, after consideration of all the complex factors bearing on the question, "we believe that our present policy is that best calculated to preserve peace and stability in the Near East."

**NEW YORK (WNS)** Vice President Hubert Humphrey, addressing the annual Weismann Dinner sponsored by the American Committee for the Weismann Institute of Science voiced hope that "the nations of the Middle East may live securely in peace with each other, to their common benefit."

**NEW YORK (WNS)** One of the largest Orthodox synagogues in this city, the West Side Institutional Synagogue, was destroyed by a fire. All of the 24 Sacred Scrolls were saved by firemen who were mindful of their sanctity.

**JERUSALEM (WNS)** Arriving here on a ten-day visit to Israel, Senator Abraham A. Ribicoff of Connecticut said the tour was concerned with a study of the aid Israel was receiving from the United States and the assistance it was giving to developing countries.

**New York: --** An historic first conference of Solomon Schechter Day Schools in North America, sponsored by the United Synagogue of America Commission on Jewish Education, will be held Sunday and Monday, Dec. 26-27 at the Waldorf Astoria in New York City. Dr. Louis Finkelstein, Chancellor of The Jewish Theological Seminary, will deliver the keynote address to an expected audience of 300-400, composed of rabbis, educators, administrators and laymen, representing a cross-section of the Conservative Movement.

**New York:** The annual awards luncheon of the National Women's League of the United Synagogue of America will be held December 16th, launching the league's Combined Campaign for \$1,000,000 in behalf of The Jewish Theological Seminary of America.

*Reno's Jewish Community Salutes Gov. Sawyer*

**BONN (WNS)** Six Nazi SS officers who were acquitted two years ago will be tried anew on charges of complicity in the murder of more than 150,000 Jews in the infamous Chelmo death camp in Poland, it was announced by the prosecutor's office.

The six were codefendants in the earlier trial with a group of accessories who were found guilty. One of the convicted criminals received a fifteen year prison term and several others were given terms ranging from eighteen months to three years.

The six acquitted men rested their claim of innocence on the contention that they had "merely followed

orders." As they left the courtroom, five of them were immediately arrested. In asking for a new trial, the prosecutor said the accused

were "fully guilty" and that there was no basis to the claim that they had been forced to commit crimes "since nobody had compelled them to perform those hideous crimes."
