Immigration and Naturalization

Who is right about America's Immigration and Naturalization Law -- Senator Jim Eastland of Mississippi and Mrs. William H. Sullivan, President of the Daughters of the American Revolution, or Dwight Eisenhower, Harry Truman, Lyndon B. Johnson and the late John F. Kennedy?

Most of the people reading these words will have little hesitancy in agreeing that the nefarious McCarran-Walter Law, rooted in the earlier Johnson Law, should have removed from it the vermiform growth known as the national origins quota principle. Yet down in Washington, mail is said to be running 9 to 1 in favor of the Eastland-Sullivan point of view.

Why are the offended Americanas silent? Why won't people speak up the way they did in the early 1950's when Senator McCarran and Representative Walter were hammering in the nails of discrimination?

Prtesting voices were heard in those days. Do you remember the five representatives of American Indian tribes writing to the then Senator Hubert Humphrey thus: "As America's only non-immigrants, we would like to go on record as being opposed to the major aspects of the McCarran immigration bill... We are against this bill because of its basic philosophy... which accepts and provides for the continuance of racial discrimination... As American Indians, we are not immediately threatened by laws to stop immigration and to deport men and women born abroad. Sometimes we wish that we had established such

a law in 1492."
Why do we not raise our voices? Go back to the immigration debate of the 1920's, conducted in the days of the first of the Red scares, during a period of war weariness; and listen to one congressman saying quite bluntly what many of his colleagues were thinking but not expressing: "Were the immigrants now flooding our shores possessed of the same traits, characteristics, and blood of our forefathers, I would have no concern upon the problem confronting us, because in the main, they belong to the same branch of the Aryan race."
