In 1960, Judge Zenoff was honored with the award, "Most Outstanding Adult in Youth Work" by the Inter-denominational Protestant Youth Council of Southern Nevada and the Lake Mead Association award of Southern Baptist Churches for youth work.

He never neglected his civic obligations towards our community, having served as president of Las Vegas Kiwanis, and is an active member of Elks, American Legion and Marine Corps League, the branch of active duty he served in World War 2, from 1953 to 1946. He, currently, is a major on reserve.

Zenoff, whose favorite hobby is boxing, is licensed by the Nevada State Athletic Commission as a boxing judge, and many of his decisions have been determining factors in naming world champions who have fought for the titles here in Las Vegas.

Despite the fullest of daily schedules, our Dave has never once forgotten his dedication to the religion of his heritage. He is a founder of the Las Vegas Jewish Community Center and a past
