It is difficult to place one person above all others in an attempt to classify the contributions being made to the general welfare of Las Vegas, but if spreading the name of our fair city is of priority importance, then Mike Gold stands heads and shoulders above everyone of us.

Mike is responsible for no less than four radio programs emanating each week commencing with the words: "Live From Las Vegas" and carried on the full CBS net-

work, coast-to-coast of 210 stations, in addition to the Radio Free Europe broadcasts. A conservative estimate is that between 30 and 40 million persons hear the Las Vegas tag-line during each of these half-four programs.

If you can find a topper to that magnitude of spreading our name around, let us know.

It was Mike who, more than a year ago, conceived the idea of airing danceband programs direct from major hotels here and established Las Vegas as the leader of all cities in live network shows. This week Freddy Martin of the Dunes, Orrin Tucker of the Mint, Guy Lombardo of the Tropicana and Jan Garber of the Desert Inn will supply the tunes for dancing all over the U. S. and in major cities of Europe. In Southern Nevada the programs are heard every Saturday, commencing at 1:05 p.m. The station, of course, is K-LUC, the local CBS affiliation.

SALZBURG (WNS) The trial of two Nazi brothers accused of involvement in the liquidation of Jews in Poland was interrupted when court spectators broke out into a demonstration on behalf of the defendants.

Prior to the outbreak, Victor Bach of New York testified that both brothers had participated in the liquidation of the Jewish Intelligence Service at Stanislaw

LONDON (WNS) Discovery of a mass grave of 1,350 Jews in the Ukrainian City of Kherson was reported here from Moscow.

The mass grave, holding the victims of Nazi bestiality during the occupation was uncovered by workers who were excavating the site for new construction.

### Israeli Prayer Freedom

JERUSALEM (WNS) The Israeli Cabinet, at a meeting held against the background of the current controversy over the denial of facilities of worship to Reform and conservative worshippers, held that all people in Israel were entitled to pray "at any place in any form."

Premier Levi Eshkol told the Cabinet that an investigation he conducted showed there was no substance to the charge of pressure on groups who would make their facilities available for worship by Reform Jews. Nor,

he said, was there proof that the Tel Aviv municipality had threatened to impose higher taxes on the B'nai B'rith group if it permitted the use of its building by Reform worshippers.

Cabinet affirmation of the right to pray in "any place in any form" did not mean to imply that Reform and Conservative rabbis in Israel can now perform marriage ceremonies and other official acts that are now within the purview of the Chief Rabbinate.
