### Rabbi Shot At Services

DETROIT (WNS) Rabbi Morris Adler, a leading rabbinic figure in Conservative Judaism and spiritual head of Congregation Shaarey Zedek in suburban South field is fighting for his life in a local hospital, the victim of a mad worshipper who shot the rabbi and himself as a shocked congregation looked on first in disbelief and then in helplessness.

Rabbi Adler was about to finish a bar mitzvah service when he saw the assailant, Richard S. Wisnetsky, climbing to the pulpit. Before Rabbi Adler could take in the scene, the 23-year-old, a
