JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

TEL AVIV (WNS) A twenty-one-year-old great granddaughter of the famed German poet Heinrich Heine has asked the Israel rabbinate to convert her to Judaism, it was disclosed here in a report by Yediot Achronot, Hebrew daily, which said the young lady had arrived in Israel some time ago for the specific purpose of changing faiths.

WASHINGTON (WNS) Record purchases of \$7,873,720 in Israel Bonds in 1965 was reported at an executive committee of B'nai B'rith's Commission on Israel.

NEW YORK (WNS) Sam Hartstein, director of public relations at Yeshiva University, has been elected president of the Metropolitan College Public Relations Council, succeeding Robert D. Noble, secretary of Hofstra University.

MONTREAL (WNS) A resolution calling on the federal government of Canada to outlaw hate-mongering by making it a penal offense was adopted unanimously by the Ontario Legislature.

ATLANTIC CITY, J.J. (WNS) Wider personal participation by young American Jews in adult Jewish education programs and in Jewish communal affairs was urged at the 12th annual workshop conference of the Farband-Labor Zionist Order.

PHILADELPHIA, Pa. (WNS) Dr. Abraham A. Neuman has resigned from his post as president of Dropsie College because of ill health.

NEW YORK (WNS) The first synagogue building in the Lincoln Center cultural hub in New York City will rise next Spring, it was announced by Daniel Mars, president of the Lincoln Square Synagogue and prominent realtor.

GENEVA (WNS) An anti-Semitic book peppered with lengthy quotations from the infamous Protocols of the Elders of Zion and other sources has been ordered seized by a Lausanne court and all unsold copies impounded.

LONDON (WNS) What is a cook to do if he has found favor in the eyes of a princess' and, more particularly, if he is the chief cook in one of London's most kosher restaurants?

Bambos Pais, chef at Bloom's Kosher Restaurant in London's East Side, will most likely take his own counsel in making the decision whether to remain in the kosher kitchen or to bow to an invitation by Princess Margaret to become her chef at Kensington Palace.

TEL AVIV (WNS) Israel's new Ashdod port has been ordered closed down because of labor troubles.

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (WNS) Reduction of the United Nations Emergency Force along the Israel-Egyptian border was announced officially by the U.N. Secretariat in a statement which said the action was the result of recommendations recently made by a survey team that examined the problem for Secretary-General U Thant.

Wayne Redd To Four Queens

Ben Goffstein, President of the Four Queens Hotel and Casino, Downtown Las Vegas, announced the appointment of Wayne Redd to the position of Assistant to the President. In addition to his executive duties, Redd will administer the advertising, publicity, and promotional operations of the Four Queens.

Redd winds up his nine-year tenure as advertising and publicity director of the Riviera Hotel on February 15th and joins the Four Queens staff on the 16th.

A business administration graduate of Washington and Jefferson College and a 1950 graduate of Carnegie Tech with a B.S. in printing and advertising administration, Redd came to Las Vegas with his family in 1954. He, his lovely wife, Lynda Leigh, and their two charming daughters reside on a five-acre ranch in the Paradise Valley area of Las Vegas.

The Four Queens is scheduled for a mid-summer opening, either June or the first of July. A five and a half million dollar fun-facility being built by Ben Goffstein and Associates, the new downtown hotel is master-planned for 850 rooms upon completion which will be executed in four phases.
