Slew 70,000

BONN (WNS) Witnesses the trial in East Berlin of Dr. Horst Fischer have testified that the Nazi Medic had been involved in the extermination of 70,000 inmates in the infamous Ausschwitz death camp, where he was a "selection doctor" for the gas chambers.

Dr. Fischer was arrested in June of 1965 after having lived for twenty years in East Germany under his own name, All he did to conceal his identity was to remove a tatoo on his arm which he wore as an SS official.

The accused Nazi has admitted guilt.
