
Remarkable County Clerk Operates Efficient Office to Serve Public

In addition, the office is charged with duties as exofficio clerk of the Eighth Judicial District Court, Board of County Commissioners, Board of Equalization, County Licensing Board, County Sanitation Districts 1 and 2, Disastet Control Board, County Annexation Board and the General Obligation Bond Board, to name a few.

Records of 165,200 civil cases are on file and available at a moment's notice, and more than \$1,000,000 a year in child support payments are handled by the County Clerk.
