NEW YORK (WNS) Senator Edward Kennedy of Mass., addressing a dinner here of the Brandeis University trustees, demanded U.N. elimination of aid to Arab refugees enlisted in the Palestine Liberation Army.

TEL AVIV (WNS) Adin Talbar, assistant director-general for international affairs in Israel's Ministry of Commerce and Industry, announced that Israel this year will sell \$1,000,000 worth of explosives to West Germany.

NEW YORK (WNS) More than 2,000 Americans from all parts of the U.S. and Canada will participate in a number of work and study projects in Israel this summer, while several hundred youths will be leaving for year-round study projects in Israel, it was announced here by Mrs. Rose L. Halprin, chairman of the Jewish Agency-American Section.

CHICAGO (WNS) A gift of \$500,000 by Mr. and Mrs. Harry Blum of this city for the construction of a pavilion at the Michael Reese Hospital and Medical Benter was announced by the president of the institution's board of trustees, Harold H. Hines, Jr.

WASHINGTON (WNS) A warning that the U.S. Government was secretly negotiating a \$150,000,000 aid deal with Egypt despite Cairo's barring of the U.S. Sixth Fleet from its ports was sounded on the floor of the Senate by Senator Vance Hartke, Indiana Democrat.

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y. (WNS) Israel's permanent Ambassador to the United Nations, Michael S. Comay, and U.N. Secretary-General U Thant conferred here for more than thirty minutes on recent developments in the Middle East, It is believed the conferees discussed the recruitment of Arab refugees into the armed forces of the Palestine Liberation Organization, whose announced purpose is war against Israel,

TEL AVIV (WNS) An anonymous donor whose name is to be announced at a later date has contributed \$500,000 to the Israel Education Fund of the United Jewish Appeal for the construction of five sports centers at high schools here, it was disclosed here by Los Angeles Jewish community leader Joseph D. Shane.

NEW YORK (WNS) The Brooklyn Jewish Center, one of the leading congregations in the Borough of Brooklyn, turned over 5,000 volumes, many of them rare items, to the Jewish Theological Seminary of America.

TEL AVIV (WNS) An operating budget of \$7,000,000 for the fiscal year was approved here by the executive council of the Weizmann Institute of Science.

NEW YORK (WNS) A bold move to meet the critical shortage of qualified teachers in Jewish education was unveiled by Yeshiva University when it announced establishment of a Hebrew teachers college with a gift of \$1,250,000 by the Jewish philanthropist Jakob Michael in memory of his late wife Erna Sondheimer Michael.

PARIS (WNS) Inclusion of the Soviet Union in the 1950 Tripartite Declaration guaranteeing the territorial integrity of all states in the Middle East was reportedly discussed here at a forty-minute conversation between French Foreign Minister Maurice Couve de Murville and Israeli Ambassador Walter Eytan,
