Letter from Marshall

Aug. 5, 1966

Your article on my candidacy for the Governorship of Nevada, as printed on August 5, 1966, is the most damnable set of lies and misrepresentations about me which I have ever seen printed anywhere -- including the four year smear campaign which has been conducted against me by the Las Vegas Sun.

It is most painful and grievous to me to see you print this pack of lies and distorted half-truths since you have always professed to be a friend to me and I have always until now valued your friendship. Please consider that friendship at an end. I desire to have nothing further to do with an irresponsible brand of journalism that could devise such a shameless political smear.

For the record I hope you will make it clear to your readers that I deny completely and without reservation your statements to the effect that I have made commitments to the John Birch Society or to Birch Society members and that such persons are already working hard in my behalf. I have never told you or any other person such a thing because it is patently false and everyone familiar with my candidacy knows it.

At the conclusion of last week's column discussing the fluctuating momentum of the Jewish vote, we were at the point of distinguishing preconditions that influence a voter's opinion about a candidate and an issue.

"Too often," we said, "the individual voter knows more about the issue he is interested in, than the men who seek his vote."

If candidates don't think this perspective is too important, political analysts have determined that 30% more votes are cast each election from persons who are interested in issues, than all others.
