nations are accusing Jordan of appeasement toward Israel. Now back to the U.N. and Goldberg.

The U.S. representative is currently the president of the U.N.'s 15-member Security Council. After Israel's reprisal raid, Arab nations demanded the sternest measures be applied to Israel by the world body. The censorship vote passed 14 to 0, with New Zealand abstaining. That's the item, with which we are most concerned.

With the U.S., Britain and France going along with Russia and her Satelite countries, plus the Arab nations, Frank Corner, New 7ealand's representative expressed disgust at the one-sided aspect of the resolution. Others, Ambassador Kironde of Uganda, who reluctantly voted for the resolution but who stated his delegation is very unhappy about it, and the Netherlands and Uruguay, who also voted for the resolution, stated it was not enough to merely draft a paper. A solution must be found.

In Washington, the state department theory is that an Israeli-Arab conflict at this time may give pro-Communistic Arabs an opportunity to grasp Jordan and Saudi Arabia, thus eliminating two friends of democratic America from the Middle East.

Rep. Seymour Halpern of New York, said he was disturbed to find the U.S. siding with Russia at the U.N. against the Israeli reprisal raid, when "the U.S. responded so forcefully to North Vietnamese infiltration and terrorism." He continued, "I do not understand why we single out one incident from a complicated chain of events to blame Israel for defending herself?" A final significant statement by Rep. Halpern, in an article that appeared in the Jewish Standard of New Jersey, was he did not think the U.S. stand was "either fair or in the national security interests of the U.S."

It is well known that ambassadors are merely spokesmen for the nations they represent, but Goldberg, we believe, is more than that. He is an opinion and policy maker for the U.S.

We can understant how Goldberg, a Jew, would bend over backward to assure the other nations and the people of the U.S., he will not allow his religion to effect his actions for this country. But why must Israel be penalized because a Jew desires to maintain his reputation for fairness? This is most evident by his constant refusal to condemn the Arab intrusions, but is foremost to censure the Jewish State. This is not the American way, according to this writer's chandards.

One syndicated writer, David Horowitz, from the United Nations, claims that on the next guerrilla attack, Israel

should start open warfare to take over the two bulges, which would cut off the Dead Sea and Jordan River, to give the Jewish State a natural border on the east front, which has been the root cause of the infiltrations. If the U.S. does not execute Justice, says Horowitz, then Israel must do it herself.

We do not agree, nor disagree with Horowitz. We do not approve of suggestions for so grave a decree like full scale warfare. We have confidence in the leaders of Israel, who will know how far they have to go, when, where and against whom.

Whatever action Israel takes, will receive total, unqualified support from the Israelite, except, of course, if it is directly against the interests of the United States, which we hope and pray will never come about.
