Las Vegas residents nearing age 65 should go to their local social security office to enroll in the medicare program, Ed Cocks, District Manager of the Social Security Office, announced.

Although there is no time limit to sign up for the

hospital insurance part of medicare, there is a set period of time in which a person can enroll in the medical insurance (doctor bill insurance) program.

For his doctor bill protection to begin as soon as he reaches 65, a person must sign up in one of the 3 months before the month he reaches 65.

Hospital insurance protection can be retroactive for as many as 12 months. But the protection of the voluntary doctor bill insurance is delayed one to 3

months if application is made during the month he reaches 65 or the 3 remaining months in the 7-month enrollment period. Any delay beyond that 7-month enrollment period may mean a wait of up to 2 years.

You do not need to be retired to be eligible for medicare. People who are still working should get in touch with the Las Vegas Social

Security Office in the three months before the month they

reach 65. In this way, they establish their entitlement to health insurance protection under medicare.

The Las Vegas Social Security Office is at 601 S. 13th Street. The office hours are Mondays 8:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. (starting on January 9). Tuesday through Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The telephone number is 382-6771.
