Swig of San Francisco, Conference Chairman. They are the General Chairman of the United Jewish Appeal, Mr. Max M. Fisher of Detroit; Ambassador Avraham Harman, the Ambassador of Israel to the United States and Rabbi Herbert A. Friedman, Executive Vice-Chairman of the United Jewish Appeal.

Rabbi Friedman will speak on the subject, "ISRAEL'S INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL PROBLEMS--HOW DO THEY AFFECT THE 1967 CAMPAIGN?"

Mr. Fisher was recently elected to his third consecutive term as head of the nationwide United Jewish Appeal, which is generally considered the top humanitarian position in the American Jewish community.
