Meanwhile, may we suggest: TO ERR IS HUMAN, TO FORGIVE, etc.



can Jewish Organizations and honorary president of the American Jewish Congress, cited factors that intensify reactionary tendencies in the German republic. These, he said, include the widespread belief in Europe that Germany has been abandoned by the United States which is now seemingly concentrating on Asia.

Dr. Prinz, once a prominent spiritual leader in Berlin, was principal speaker at the banquet session which closed the Hadassah's midwinter conference at the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel. More than 200 leaders, representing 318,000 members throughout the United States and Puerto Rico, participated in

the three-day conference.

Describing the German National Democratic Party, Dr. Prinz said that its two leaders, Thielen and von Thadden, "are very dangerous men" even though "neither of them was a Nazi."

The party, he said, is trying to rally surviving followers of Hitler, the discontended middle classes, and the "angry young men" in a rust.

At another session, Mrs. Siegfried Kramarsky, national chairman of the Hadassah Medical Organization Committee in the U.S., reported a \$172,000 grant from the U.S. Institute of Health at Bethesda, Md., for the establishment in Israel of a dialysis machine, a device for the treatment of kidney
