Dr. Hagen Staack will be host for the series. He is professor of religion at Muhlenberg College, Allentown, Pa., and is familiar to "Frontiers of Faith" viewers for his previous appearances on the program as lecturer on Biblical and archaeological subjects,

Guests and interpreters for their own faith traditions will be the Rev. Thomas E. Ambrogi, S. J., professor of ecumenics, Woodstock (Md.) College; the Rev. Robert G. Stephanopoulos, pastor of the Church of Our Saviour, Rye, N.Y.; and Rabbi Marc H. Tanenbaum, National Director of Interreligious Affairs, American Jewish Committee. over are discussed. In Part Three (March 19) the timing of Good Friday in relation to the Jewish Passover is noted, and the Orthodox ritual is performed. Music is by St. Vladimir's Theological Seminary Octet of Crestwood, N.Y. In Part Four (March 25) the completion of the Passover and Easter cycles with the observance of Shovuos and Pentecost, respectively, are examined.

All four participants have commented on the importance of the series.

Rabbi Tanenbaum said: "In light of the unprecedented character of 'The Holy Seasons' the National Council of Churches and the National Broadcasting Company are to be congratulated for their leadership in this pioneering undertaking. 'Mass media ecumenism' of this kind may well be the secret weapon of the entire ecomenical and interreligious movements. Mass media ecumenism represents one of the truly imaginative and powerful instruments to close the gaps between the generals and the ecumenical troops, and this series is a splendid and dramatic illustration of how it can be done."
