PARADISE SPA HAS WHIRLPOOL BATHS

Nippy mornings and cool evenings are no problem at the Paradise Spa with the recent remodeling of the Las Vegas condominium resort's mineral baths, reports general manager Richard E. Eckenweiller.

The warm whirlpool baths provide relaxation for cold and taut muscles, enabling residents and visitors of the 300-acre health resort to plunge into the active recreation offered there.

It was no coincidence that the Spa, its two giant health clubs and 400 homes were built at 9457 Las Vegas Blvd., South. The picturesque site was selected because it lies over deep mineral wells, points out Eckenweiller.

"We have made use of the wells to provide a network of steam baths and a man-made lake which winds through the property," he explains.

King-size swimming pools also add to the invigorating atmosphere of the vacation and permanent home complex. They, too, are heated year-round for appropriate comfort.

The private whirlpool baths in the health clubs are especially suitable as a follow up to strenuous exercise, says program director Tony Ciulla.

"After horseback riding, golf, volley ball or any of the participation sports offered here at the Spa, a relaxing whirlpool permits you to unwind in true luxury," he avers.

Sauna baths and gymnasiums also have been valuable for those Spa residents and guests who wish to reduce or firm up their muscles.

These facilities, including massage and beautifying programs are available to residents and visitors alike, it was pointed out. For those who have taken up residence in the comfortable one, two and three-bedroom homes, Spa membership can be included. For others there is a reasonable charge.

According to sales manager Cranston Brown, tours of home models, priced from \$13,750 to \$25,000 and the recreational complex, are held daily. Paradise Spa is located only five minutes from the Strip, towards Los Angeles.
