**REPORT FROM CARSON CITY**  
From INFORMATION Supplied By  
Assemblymen  
Zel Lowman And Frank Young

(Editor's Note: The lengthy sessions starting at 8 a.m. and running into the wee hours are commencing to take their toll on our elected representatives. They are truly weary, but determined to bring their efforts to a culmination. They deserve a nod of appreciation at this time. J.T.)

With the passing, last week, of the sixtieth legislative day, both the tempo and the pressure have increased in the Fifty-fourth Session of the Nevada State Legislature. Bills of a substantive nature have now begun reaching the Assembly floor and the study in human nature, which Zel Lowman (Assembly, Dist. 4) finds the Legislature to be, is even more interesting than before.

Probably the most important thing done by the Judiciary Committee, of which he is a member, has been the consideration and reporting out of Assembly Bills 71 and 81, the first revision of the Nevada Criminal Code since 1911. A great deal of time has been spent in hearings and it is certainly hoped the

Senate will go along with Assembly suggestions. More heat was generated on the penalties of the use, possession and selling of marijuana than any issue to date. As a long time student of its effects on the individual and its direct pathway to heroin, Lowman stood firmly on retaining punishment for all three as felonies. He is happy to say the Assembly agreed.

"I am particularly proud of the Clark County delegation and their demeanor in the Assembly, and of my Republican Colleague, Senator Chic Hecht, in the other house," Lowman added. "It's a pleasure to serve with solid, stable people who consider every measure on its merits rather than from a solely political viewpoint."

Lowman's message to Israeliite readers: "Please let me know when you have opinions on specific issues. I do not promise to vote as you would have me but to give every measure my best, based on the information I have."

From Frank Young, Las Vegas Assemblyman: "My first and growing impressions of State government

concern the great need for more planning--longer than two years. The very real tragedy that the University is now involved in regarding the Northern Regents trying to get a medical school through comes in the face of no real long range--10 to 15 year--plan for the University against which the medical school plan can be evaluated. The University's relations with the Legislature are extremely poor and the medical school issue does not help it any. It is a real task to set the medical school in perspective without further hindering the relationships between the University and the Legislature.

"As you know, I believe that an economy that is largely dependent on a single industry is living dangerously. I believe that we must look analytically at our resources and at the needs of industries and decide what industries are most in need of what we have to offer in Nevada. Having found those industries, we can then look for the companies within those industries that are ready and able to make a move to our state. This process of long range economic development has not been followed in our State's Department of Economic Development, but it is the Governor's intent that it shall do so now. I am happy to have been able to play a part in helping to formulate this plan and to help get support for it in the Legislature."
