NOTICE TO SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFICIARIES...

All persons entitled to social security checks in 1966 and who were under age 72 any part of 1966 must file an annual report with social security if earnings exceeded \$1500 in 1966.

If you are required to file an annual report, you should do so as soon as possible. THE DEADLINE, UNDER THE LAW, FOR FILING IS APRIL 15, 1967. If you wait until after April 15, you may lose extra social security payments.

Your social security office will be glad to help you with any questions you may have. You may phone or write them, or you may wish to visit them if you have a special problem. If you visit the office after receiving your Form W-2 from your employer or after completing your income tax return, please take a copy with you. However, if you mail in your annual report, please do not enclose your Form W-2 or tax return.

If you have already sent us your annual report for 1966, please do not send another unless there is a change in what you reported.
